

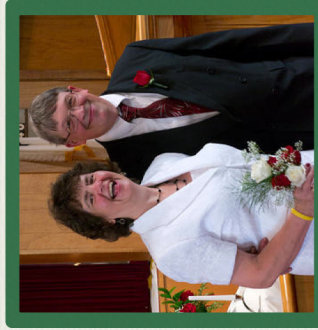

It's Tweety (Rob's plane) and I'm here to bring a little formation to the events of Rob's and Ann's 2011.

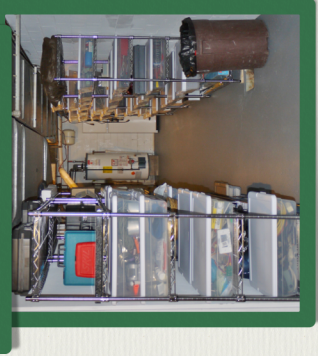
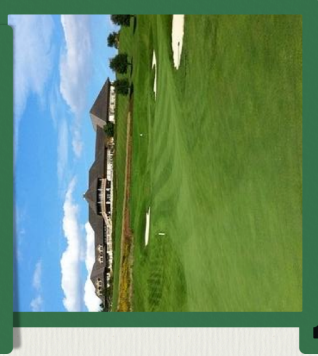
